

FOOD ANALYTICS CONFERENCE TRAVEL GRANT

Regulations

The Object of the Analytical Chemistry Trust Fund is to promote, assist and extend the science and study of Analytical Chemistry and of all questions relating to the analysis, nature and composition of natural and manufactured materials for the benefit of the public.

Purpose

These grants are designed to assist PhD students and ECRs (within 5 years of the end of their PhD) to attend the *Food Analytics Conference* that is held in Copenhagen. A grant of £500 will be awarded to successful applicants to contribute to travel and subsistence costs.

1. Applicants must be members of the Analytical Division of the Royal Society of Chemistry. The application form can be found at <http://www.rsc.org/Membership/join/admission/index.asp>.
2. Applicants must be registered for a post-graduate PhD degree by research at a UK or Irish Higher Education Institution or be an Early Career Researcher (within 5 years of the end of their PhD).
3. There is no restriction on an Applicant's nationality.
4. There is no restriction on an Applicant's age.
5. Applicants must be Normally Resident in the UK or Ireland during attendance at the conference.
8. Preference will be given to Applicants who will be presenting an oral paper or a poster or otherwise actively participating in the Conference. The title and a short extract (250 words maximum) of the oral paper or poster must be included in the application form.
9. If a grant is awarded it will be paid by BACS upon receipt of the Higher Education Institution's invoice by the Trust Administrator at the address below. The payment will be made by the Royal Society of Chemistry on behalf of the Analytical Chemistry Trust Fund.
10. Within thirty days of the end of the conference the Applicant should write a conference report for inclusion in *Analytical Matters* highlighting the meeting and what they got out of it, with the inclusion of photos if GDPR allows.
11. The decision of the Trustees is final.
12. If, for any reason, the Applicant fails to attend the conference, the grant must be returned to the Trust Administrator.
13. Applicants must acknowledge the support of the 'Analytical Chemistry Trust Fund' in their oral or poster presentation.
